NORMS FOR GRANTING FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PRESENTING PAPERS IN CONFERENCES FOR UG/DD/PG/PH.D STUDENTS/SCHOLARS (A.4: RES NO.02/2015 – 25th SENATE)

a. Eligibility:

1. UG/DD/PG students must possess a minimum CGPA of 8.0 and above.
2. The paper accepted must be thoroughly reviewed.
3. The event must be organized by a reputed Institute.
4. Scholar(s) / Student(s) should present the paper in the Conference/Seminar.
5. Only original articles are permitted. No support will be provided for review or survey articles.

b. Assistance:

1. II AC by Train by the shortest route
2. DA @ Rs.200/- per day subject to a maximum of 7 days (Auto fare of Rs.75/- per trip to a maximum of four trips)
3. Accommodation expenses subject to a maximum of Rs.1000/- per day on submission of documents will be reimbursed.
4. Registration fees: Actual registration fee subject to a maximum of Rs.3,000/- for a National Conference and Rs.5,000/- for an international Conference held within India.
5. Maximum number of events permitted in a calendar year is one.
