Instructions for CoWE

- a) Comprehensive Written Examination will be held only after successful completion of course work prescribed and approved by the DC.
- b) The completed CoWE can be submitted to the Research Coordinator
- c) The duration of examination for each of the three courses, and the requirement to pass the examination is given below.

Sl. No.	Maximum Marks	Minimum Marks to Pass	Duration of the Examination

- d) Only after successful completion of CoWE, the student can take up the Comprehensive Oral Examination (COE).
- e) A student failing in the CoWE in the first attempt will be given a second attempt not before one month but within six months from the date of the first attempt. If the student fails in the second attempt, she/he will not be allowed to continue in the PhD program. The period of six months between the first and second attempts may be extended up to a maximum of one year in special cases with the approval of the chairman DC/ Director.
