RULES GOVERNING COURSE REGISTRATION

1. A Ph.D. student will have to credit 2 core courses, as suggested by the DC and offered by the Institute. In addition, two elective courses are to be completed. In all these courses, the scholar should secure a minimum CGPA of 7.5 and minimum of "C" grade in the prescribed courses. The prescribed courses shall be post-graduate level courses of the Institute or from IIT / IMSc / MoU Institutes on case to case basis.
2. The courses already successfully completed by the scholar in their UG / Master's Programme will not be considered by the Doctoral Committee for the course work requirements. Changes in prescribed courses shall be made only by the Doctoral Committee. The doctoral Committee may prescribe additional courses for a scholar wherever found necessary
3. The elective course (Maximum of one course with at least 3 credits) can be taken from NPTEL (where NPTEL conducts Examinations in a regular manner) based on the approval of DC. The grade secured by the students from NPTEL will be considered for CGPA calculation after proper transformation proposed by the DC. The scholar needs to score more than 65% marks for transfer of credits.
4. In case of HTRA scholars, the number of NPTEL courses they could credit as part of the course work is one in which they need to score at least 65% marks. External candidates may be considered to have completed the credit requirement with two in-house courses with a minimum CGPA of 7.5 and two online courses (with at least 3 credits) from NPTEL in which they should score at least 65 % marks.
5. Only PG Level NPTEL courses can be credited by M Tech Research / PhD Scholars.
